2023 WAC Little Dribblers Basketball Tournament Rules

1. **The entry fee is \$25.00 per kid listed on your roster.** There will be no refunds after schedules are sent out.
2. Each team will be responsible for providing a clock keeper/or bookkeeper.
3. **Eligibility Requirements for Participants:** For 3rd/4th graders, has not reached his/her 11th birthday on or before September 1st, 2022. For 5th/6th graders, has not reached his/her 13th birthday on or before September 1st, 2022. If eligibility is questioned, the participant must provide proof before the next game.
4. PLEASE, notice the dates that the games will be scheduled on. If there is a day that your team is unable to play please let us know when you send the information back to us. Number of games will depend on the number of teams entered.
5. **Full court pressing will be allowed until your team is up by 15 points.**
6. All players must wear a jersey or shirt with a number(s) on the front and/or back.
7. **A technical foul will result in the opposing team getting an automatic two points and the ball.**
8. Games will consist of two 15-minute quarters. There will be 5 minutes between halves.
9. Each team will have 3 time outs per game. Each time out will be one minute long.
10. **The clock will run continuously except for injuries, and time outs. The clock will stop the last minute of the 2nd half on all dead balls, and in overtime. However, if a team is leading by 15 points or more the clock will run except on timeouts.**
11. Each team is to check in five minutes before the game is scheduled to begin. A forfeit will be called if one or both teams have not checked in by the scheduled game time.
12. A player will be removed from the game if he/she receives five personal fouls and/or he/she receives 2 technical fouls.
13. Overtime: 2 minutes for the first OT, all others will be “sudden death” first team to score wins.
14. In case of unsportsmanlike conduct the referee may:
 - a. Warn the player the first time.
 - b. Eject the player from the game the first time.
 - c. Report the players’ name to the Facility Manager and forfeit the team’s game if conduct continues.
15. Any player or coach that is ejected from a game must come and talk to the Facility Manager before playing or coaching again.

NOTE:

One of the calculated risks that participants must accept is that coaches, other players, and officials may make mistakes during the course of the game. We are all human beings and subject to human mistakes.
